

The Garden of Remembrance

Memorial Plaques

The Chapel at Seaside (the "Chapel") has developed the land on the north side of the Chapel to become "The Garden of Remembrance". When approaching from the west, a beautiful cenotaph welcomes you into a garden of trees, plantings, water features and pathways that reflect native landscaping and serve as a visible reminder of our belief in God's grace and beauty. The garden's lower tier, closest to the Chapel, is a place for gathering with friends and family and making memories. The upper tier is a more somber place, ideal for reflection and contemplation, with a single row of plaques on the rear wall to memorialize loved ones who are reposed elsewhere.

The limited number of available plaques -- approximately 120 on the rear wall and 25 on the cenotaph -- are intended to memorialize those who loved Seaside and the Chapel. Plaques are available for a fee, for either immediate inscription to recognize loved ones who have passed or to be reserved for the future, subject to the guidelines below:

- Applications for commissioned or reserved plaques must be approved by the Chapel
- Fee: Rear wall \$5,000; Cenotaph \$10,000
- Size 12" x 12"
- Name, year of birth and year of death will be inscribed in the specified fonts
- Maximum number of characters in the name may be limited by the font design
- No variations of design are allowed
- All inscriptions will be made by the Chapel
- Plaques will be installed by the Chapel
- Location of plaques on either the rear wall or cenotaph will be assigned by the Chapel (preference will be given to applicant's desired location)
- Tax deductible
