Did you know?

Blessed to be a Blessing

This past year, you, The Chapel community, and everyone who calls this place home, has been very generous to support the missional efforts to care for the world around us. We believe there is a truth in the scriptures that we are blessed to be a blessing to others. Living out that blessing is what we like to call, "Kingdom living." It is the way Christ lived and calls us to live as well. In Matthew, Jesus says to feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, welcome the stranger, clothe the naked, visit the sick, visit the prisoners, and in James, it says to care for the widow and orphans.

So, this year we worked to do just that. On Christmas Eve we committed to giving away 50% of our offering and, over the course of the whole year, we gave away more than a 1/3 of our tithes and offerings. Because of your generosity and partnership with us, we were able to give over \$200,000 away to meet the needs of those in our community and beyond.

We responded to natural disasters and caring for refugees in Ukraine. We provided meals and Christmas gifts for those in our community who would have gone without. We proclaimed the good news of Jesus with both our words and actions in Walton County and beyond. We have had some long standing partners in ministry like Young Life, Food For Thought, and Caring and Sharing among many others, and we have expanded to continue to meet more needs in areas that may get overlooked. Including organizations like Be Generous, who works to rescue women from addiction and trafficking and Songs in the Night and Crowned for Ashes, who cares for young widows and the fatherless. And, we worked with the Chaplains at Walton County Correction to help the men be rehabilitated to become the husbands, fathers, men and good neighbors we have all been called to be.


We also partnered with His Voice Global as they are working to redeem, restore, and renew in Africa. We believe God has positioned the Chapel at Seaside in a unique place to have an incredible impact here in the panhandle and around the world, so we are working to proclaim this goodnews in both word and deed from Seaside to the ends of the earth.




