We are in a season of reflection, refinement, and restoration leading up to our Easter Celebration. The Chapel at Seaside is a simple church as far as function goes, but we hope we are a deep well offering Jesus' living water to all who are thirsty. We hope our Easter services are a refreshing celebration for you and your family. If you are in town, consider joining us for one or all of our Holy Week services.

Palm Sunday - Sunday, April 2nd at 10:00am at The Chapel.

Maundy Thursday Communion Service - Thursday, April 6th at 6:00pm at The Chapel.

We will have a communion service at the Chapel where we remember Jesus' final meal.

Good Friday Service - Friday, April 7th at 6:00pm at The Chapel.

This is a reflective service as we turn our hearts to the story of Jesus' death.

Easter Sunday - We will have three opportunities to celebrate our resurrected King.

6:00am Sunrise service on the beach. Enter the beach at the Seaside Obelisk through the Coleman Pavilion. This service can accommodate the most amount of people and is a beautiful way to start your Easter Sunday. Come in any attire and bring a blanket or a chair.

8:30am at The Chapel. This service traditionally has the lowest attendance of all the services. This year we will have a tent for our overflow on the lawn.

10:00am at The Chapel. Traditionally our most popular service. We will have a tent for overflow on the lawn.


