We hope you get your kids some toys from the front room and point others to do the same. We hope you get older kids checked into Kids church and point the way for a visitor. We hope you take a second to introduce yourself to the people in the seats around you so that everyone understands that Church is about community and this is a really strong, welcoming and fun loving community! We pray that you feel able to be the hand and feet of Jesus to others who may not feel comfortable in a new space. I already said we are a unique community...you NEVER know who you are going to get the chance to bless by just saying "good morning."

If you are someone who calls this place home for even a few weeks a year, have you considered that you could quite literally be the face that represents Christ to someone who needs to know that they are welcomed in this space?

Did you know that it takes at least 9 volunteers to get people seated, hand out bulletins, make sure blankets are out in the cold seasons and fans in the hot seasons. Did you also know that we live in a very transient community where people travel a LOT. If you have called this place home for any reasonable amount of time, we would love for you to consider being someone who welcomes our worshipers...what a privilege it is to say, "you are welcome here."
