

### What a Weekend

There are a few days that seem to hold a special significance for everyone.

Championship games, award ceremonies, launching of new products or businesses, or celebrating an accomplishment. But most of those events are surrounded by big fanfare and production. For followers of Jesus, one of the days that is so significant takes place in a quiet garden outside Jerusalem in the early morning hours, with just a few Roman soldiers on guard and a few followers of Jesus who make their way to a tomb to grieve the loss of their friend. A quiet morning was the pivotal moment in history. I love a good party, a big celebration, lots of production and fanfare...but it is also so amazing to gather in the early morning hours on the beautiful beaches of Seaside and remember and celebrate. If you were with us on Easter morning, though I couldn't secure dolphins that morning...sorry about that, I'll try again next year...it was really quite incredible. Over the course of 3 services (1 on the beach and 2 at The Chapel) we had near 4,000 people join us for worship to celebrate our resurrected King. People from all over, locals who call The Chapel home, part time residents, and people just in town who wanted to gather and worship. One of the things about Easter is that all sorts of people will show up that day...people who are totally bought in and would never miss a worship service and people who are hesitant to the faith...and God can work beautifully in all of their lives. Easter is celebrating Jesus defeating sin and death, he restores relationships, he offers grace and forgiveness, and he calls for his followers to share his good news, to live out the ways of Jesus in both word and in action to the ends of the earth. My hope and prayer is that when people worshiped with

us on Easter, they caught a glimpse of the restoration possible, the grace and forgiveness offered, and felt the calling to follow after Jesus. On Easter, we were able to give away \$20,000 to help support our mission and outreach partners who are proclaiming good news in word and action. I hope you will join us in this journey every week...because every Sunday is a resurrection celebration, but go ahead and mark April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2026 down. There'll be another celebration in the early morning hours you won't want to miss.


