We're nearing the end of Lent; this 40-day journey of prayer, fasting, and quiet surrender. Ahead of us: the celebration of Palm Sunday, the table of the Last Supper, the weight of Good Friday, and the joy of Easter. But if we're not careful, these moments can become just dates on a calendar... familiar, but hollow. They were never meant to be that. They are invitations, meant to pull us into the very life of Jesus. A Russian nun, Maria Skobtsova, once wrote, "The meaning of the liturgy must be translated into life." In other words, if our worship isn't lived out, what is it for? In the days ahead, we will watch Jesus walk in faithful obedience all the way to the cross. And we're invited to do the same. "This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for one another."

Followers of Jesus have often considered themselves resurrected people. We are not dead, we are alive. They were called Christians, meaning little Christs because their lives emulated his life. And every Sunday was considered a mini Easter, a day of resurrection and celebration.

So as Lent comes to a close, let the transformative work of Jesus transform you. Don't just observe it, embody it. Live it. Let it shape you and the world around you. For the glory of God and the good of others, because if it isn't lived...what are we doing? I hope you will join us for worship, for all the Holy Week services, Easter Sunday, and continue to live as resurrected people.

HIS VOICE GLOBAL



Last year I, Sarah, got the opportunity to go to Africa to visit our mission partner, His Voice Global. I was able to see the work they are doing in the community and when I say the way they are working to raise up leaders among the vulnerable is a wholistic approach, it almost feels like an understatement.

We were able to visit those who needed medical attention only to realize that they are not only restoring health to those who need it, but they are also restoring dignity.
